<p><b>Title: "Get It At Dal"</b>  <b>Content:</b> How to interpret the Get it @ Dal screen</p>

<b>Screen shot</b>	<b>Script</b>
Title	The "Get It At Dal" service helps you find out if we have the article you need.
<b>Screen Caps and zoom ins of "Get It At Dal" in different locations.</b>	Dalhousie subscribes to many journals and "Get It At Dal" links your database searches to our subscriptions.  The "Get It At Dal" symbol appears in Refworks, Prowler and most database results. The Get it at Dal button is also present in WorldCat, our online catalogue, but it looks a little different.
<b>Zoom into item and "Get It At Dal" button in Prowler</b>	Let's use an article found in Prowler as an example of the options "Get It At Dal" provides.
<b>Click 'Get It At Dal' in Prowler.</b>	Clicking the button next to the article citation brings you to a screen offering several ways to find this article.
<b>Point to online journals "Go"</b>	"Get It At Dal" shows that we have an electronic journals subscription that contains this article.
<b>Open one article.</b>	Click "Go" to access the full text of the article.
<b>Close full text and open another example.</b>	Sometimes the full text is not available electronically. In this case you would go to our catalogue to see if we have a paper copy of the journal.
<b>Call out catalogue .</b>	Clicking "Go" will perform an automatic search of the catalogue.
<b>Click on catalogue "Go"</b>	
<b>Scroll through results.</b>	If a paper copy is not available, you can request one from another library, using Novanet Express.
<b>Zoom into call numbers.</b>	When we do have the paper copy available at Dal you need to find out if we carry the year you require. You will find this information under "location" in the WorldCat record. Write down the call number to retrieve this item from the library.
<b>Click on Dal location</b>	
	Underneath the option to search the catalogue, the get it at Dal screen also provides suggestions of other articles that are related to the article you are retrieving.
<b>Point to DalRelais "Go"</b>	If all else fails, you can use the document delivery service to obtain the item from almost anywhere in the world for free.
<b>Open login screen.</b>	Click Go to access the request form. You can also access this screen from within our catalogue, by clicking on the button beside an item that says "Request Item through Document Delivery."
<b>Point to Refworks "Go" and Live Help "Go"</b>	The "Get It At Dal" screen also allows you to save the article citation in the citation management tool, Refworks. If you are not using RefWorks, consider viewing our LibCast on this subject to get started.
	At the very bottom you will notice an option to, "Save Citation Information" clicking

	<p>the go button takes you to this screen, where you can retrieve a citation in several popular citation styles.</p>
