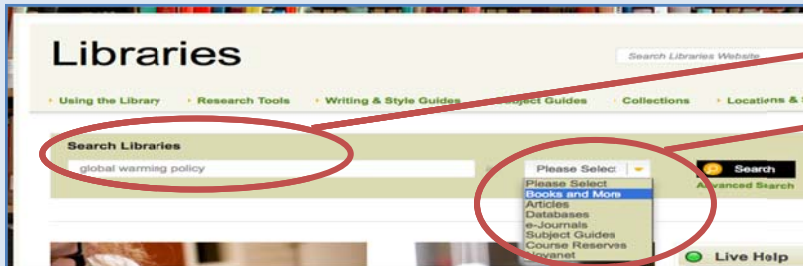




Searching with Dal WorldCat

Dal WorldCat is the library's online catalogue. WorldCat helps you search for resources at Dalhousie Libraries, at our partner NovaNet libraries, and also for materials located at libraries from around the world.

Step One: Accessing WorldCat



1. Surf to **libraries.dal.ca**.
2. Type your search terms into the main search bar.
3. Click **Books and More** on the pull-down menu and click **Search**. WorldCat will search our catalogue, the NovaNet catalogue, and other library catalogue all at once.


Step Two: Working with your results



4. Use this pull-down menu to limit your result to Dal Libraries.
5. Use these checkboxes to limit your results by format, author, and year.
6. Click the titles in main window to go to the **main record**, which gives you more information on the item.

Step Three: Exporting to RefWorks



7. Create a Dal WorldCat account by clicking on the **WorldCat icon** in the top-right corner of the screen:

8. Save items in WorldCat by marking items and saving them to a list.
9. Click the WorldCat icon to go to your account. Choose a list, click **Citations View** and then choose **Export to Refworks** on the pull-down menu.
